CHANGING THE CULTURE 2010: STRATEGIC REGIONAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL; OF HEALTHCARE-ASSOCIATED INFECTIONS IN NORTHERN IRELAND

The 2006 *Changing the Culture* action plan has been updated by the Healthcare Associated Infection (HCAI) Strategic Steering Group, chaired by Dr Elizabeth Mitchell, working in partnership with HSC colleagues. The new regional strategic action plan, entitled *Changing the Culture 2010*, is underpinned by the two core principles of the original *Changing the Culture* published in 2006, namely that infection prevention and control is an integral part of healthcare, and that it is everyone's responsibility. It is intended to bring together the priority strands of work that need to be delivered in order to accelerate progress in reducing HCAIs, and will complement the Trusts' HCAI action plans.



Changing the Culture 2010 has been approved by the Minister, who announced its publication during an Assembly debate on 11 January.
